Teresa's strategy [pasted text]

Here is a strategy for us to consider for Barber Street:

Integrate Section 4 with the Prince Avenue Corridor project at the intersection. Use TSPLOST 2018 funds to construct Sections 4 and 3, including the Oneta Street Intersection. Develop plans for *Segments 1 and 2* which can be implemented once development of the Dairy Pak area increases the need for bicycle facilities. It is possible that TAD funds could pay for some of Segments 1 and 2.

Cost estimates based on Toole's work:

1.	Raised intersection at Boulevard Park	314,000
2.	Segment 3 Oneta to Boulevard	2,724,500
3.	Oneta/Waterworks intersection redesign	391,500
4.	Segment 4 look at proposed plus alternatives	300,000 – 1.4M

Price for #1-3: \$3,430,000

Price for #4: \$300,000 – 1,400,000

**Total \$3,730,000 - \$4,830,000**
