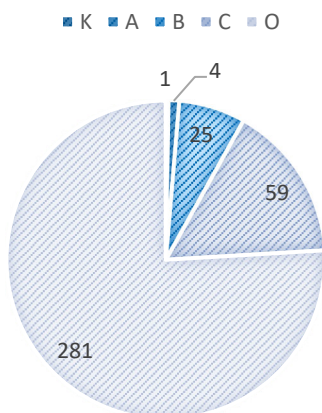

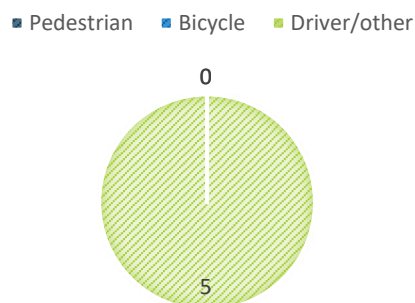

### CRASHES BY SEVERITY



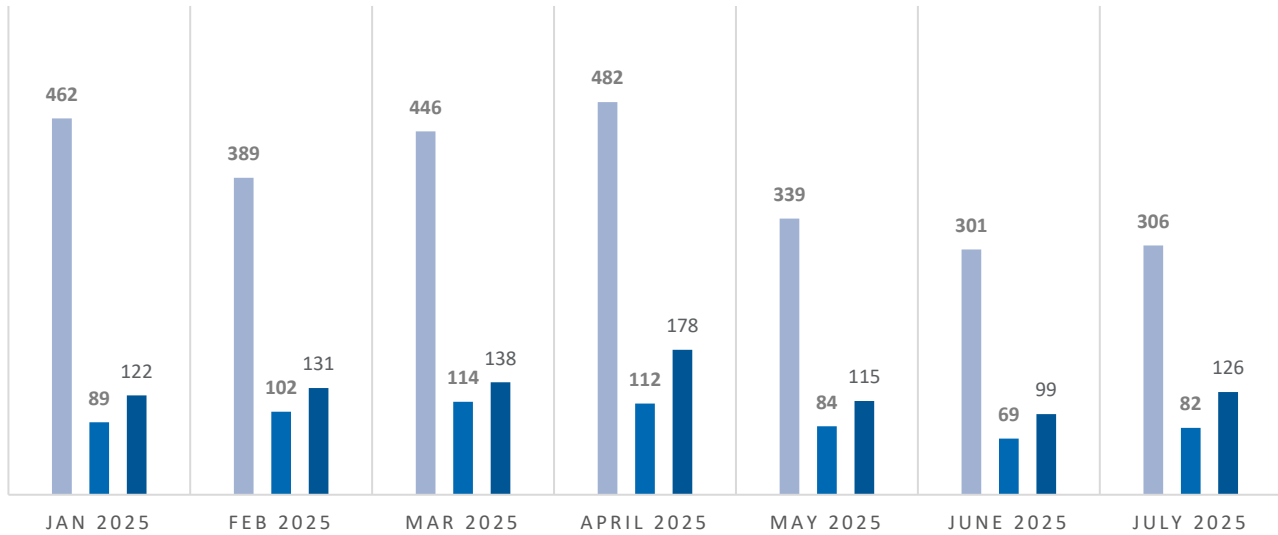
### SERIOUS INJURY AND FATAL CRASHES

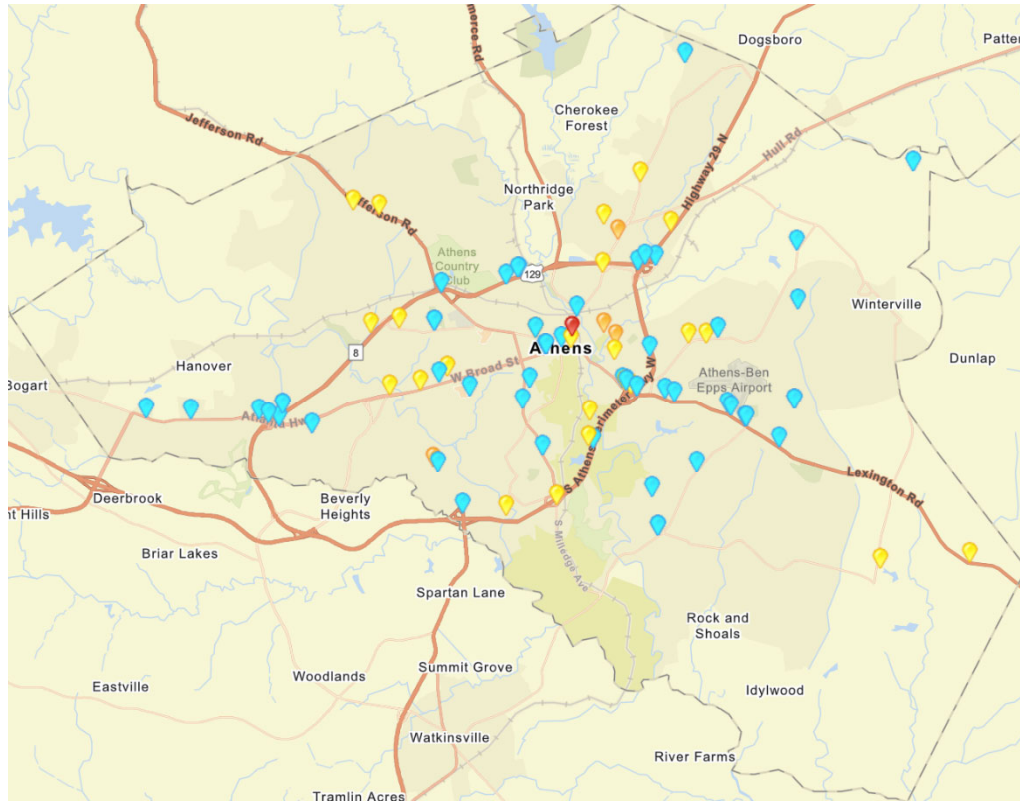

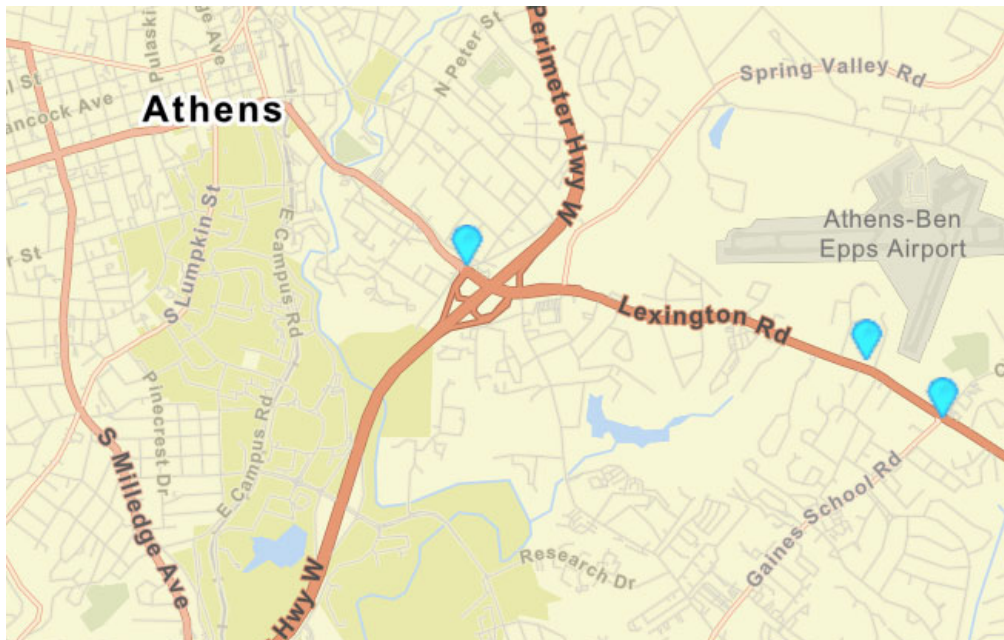

Crashes reported as K, A, B, or C

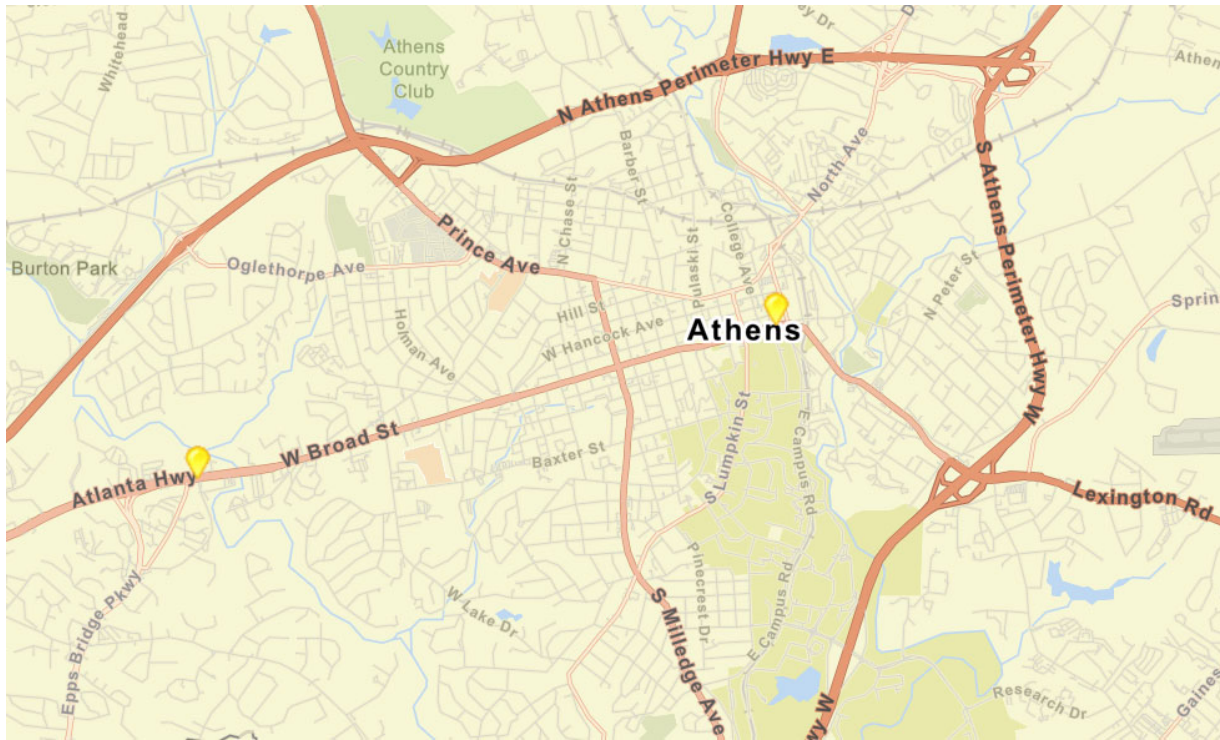


## PEDESTRIAN CRASH LOCATIONS

## **KABCO CRASH SEVERITY**

K – Fatal Injury. A reported injury of any person that produced death within 30 days after the date of the accident. Delayed deaths must be reported to the Department of Transportation.

A – Suspected Serious Injury. Any injury that prevents the injured person from walking, driving, or normally continuing the activities that that person was capable of performing prior to the accident.

B – Suspected Minor or Visible Injury. Any injury that is evident to any person other than the injured at the scene of the accident.

C – Possible Injury or Complaint. Possible injuries that are claimed or indicated by behavior but not by wounds.

O – Property Damage Only
