

**ATHENS-CLARKE COUNTY
BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES**

January 8, 2018

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Ralston moved to approve the minutes of the December 11, 2017 meeting as written. Mr. Holden seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Coordination of efforts between BPMP and the Comprehensive Plan:

Mr. Raessler responded to a question posed by Mr. Eubanks via e-mail regarding incorporating the BPMP in the Comprehensive Plan. A synopsis is provided at the end of the agenda. Planning staff will attend the February meeting to discuss the coordination efforts.

Progress Update from Toole Design Group:

Jared Draper of Toole Design Group provided heatmaps showing density of the on-line Wikimap comments. He also provided draft network maps for Committee comments.

Mr. Draper noted that ASHTO is moving to a more context-based approach for bike & ped infrastructure, as well as roadway design. The transportation side of context includes population density and building density, various parking types (lots, structures, angle or parallel parking, etc.), modes of transportation, intersection spacing, traffic volume and speed. Toole is working on definitions for the overall study area and developed a graphic that shows how ACC's context changed.
