The Unified Government of Athens-Clarke County, Georgia met this date in a special called session. Present: Mayor Girtz; Commissioners Davenport, Parker, Link, Wright, Denson, Houle, Myers, Thornton, and Hamby. Absent: Commissioner Edwards. Commissioner Thornton came in at 5:07 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider COVID-19 vaccination mandate policy; enter into executive session for discussion of real estate acquisition and/or disposal; and consider any other item in proper order.

New business – Consider under suspension of Rules

A motion was made by Commissioner Myers, seconded by Commissioner Houle, to suspend Rules of Commission for consideration of one item of new business. The motion passed by unanimous vote.
