The Mayor and Commission of the Unified Government of Athens-Clarke County, Georgia met this date in a special called session. Present: Mayor Denson; Commissioners Dickerson, Sims, Link, Wright, Bailey, NeSmith, Bell, and Herod. Absent: Commissioners Girtz, and Hamby. Commissioner Wright came in at 4:15 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider appeal of the Historic Preservation Commission's decision regarding Certificate of Appropriateness #2014-12-2408 for 440 Bloomfield Street.

Attorney Berryman gave an overview of the appeal process.

Attorney Berryman stated Mr. Totten had found a mistake in the Historic Preservation Commission minutes as to persons who voted for the denial, and Athens-Clarke stipulates to this correction.

Senior Planner Bruce Lonnee gave the staff presentation given to the Historic Preservation Commission.
