

Release and Indemnity for Type 3 Riprap Request

The undersigned property owner requests that Athens-Clarke County deliver Type 3 riprap for use in correcting expressed erosion problems at this property. The property owner shall mark the middle of the proposed rock delivery area with a stake. A sketch of the proposed delivery location along with a sketch of the proposed riprap installation area must be provided. The sketches shall include dimensions (including desired thickness) to allow locations, areas, and amounts to be determined. A copy of all permits required for the project installation shall also be provided. Deliveries will be scheduled on the next available date.

In consideration for Athens-Clarke County providing stone to the property owner, the undersigned releases and agrees to indemnify Athens-Clarke County and its agents and employees from any and all claims of any kind arising from the services requested herein. This release and indemnity includes, without limitation, damage to driveways, curbs, sidewalks, private water and sewer lines, septic systems, plants, and landscape. Furthermore, the property owner agrees to be responsible to remove any/all provided stone from the property. *Neither Athens-Clarke County nor its agents and employees will be responsible for the removal of excess stone. If materials are not installed per this agreement within sixty (60) days of delivery, the undersigned agrees to pay Athens-Clarke County \$500 per load for the cost of all materials supplied and their delivery.*

Note: (Each cubic yard of riprap equals 27 cubic feet and weighs about 1.2 tons).

7. Does the owner acknowledge that they are responsible for removing the rock from the delivery zone within 60 days of delivery? _____
8. Does the owner acknowledge that grading and other work may need to be done as part of a successful riprap installation, and that the rock riprap provided is not considered to be decorative stone? _____
9. Does the owner acknowledge that they may only participate in this program once? _____
