# Chip Felton

## SENIOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR

Since joining the Athens-Clarke County Public Utilities Department in April 2011, Chip Felton has played a key role in keeping our community's water and sewer systems flowing safely. Chip has steadily advanced through roles such as Sewer Maintenance Operator, Heavy Equipment Operator, Right of Way Crew Leader, and Capital Construction Crew Supervisor before taking on his current position as Senior Construction and Maintenance Supervisor. Today, he oversees teams of employees within the Water & Sewer Division.

A "typical" day for Chip is anything but routine. He assigns crews to projects ranging from sewer line maintenance to capital construction, clears work orders, and often jumps in to support field operations himself. This variety is his favorite part of the job: "I like the randomness. One day I'm at a desk doing paperwork, the next I'm out with a crew."

Chip's division  
manages more than  
**820 miles of water  
distribution lines**  
and **500 miles of  
sewer lines** across  
our county.

Over the years, Chip has gained a wide range of expertise. He holds a Commercial Driver's License, Backflow License, Water Distribution License, and Sewer Collection License, and has mastered equipment from boom trucks and excavators to valve insertion equipment—which allows crews to install valves in water mains without shutting off service.


Chip thinks it may surprise ACC residents that our stormwater and sewer systems are completely separate. The sewer system is an underground network of pipes that carries wastewater from our homes and businesses to a water reclamation facility for treatment, while the stormwater system is designed to move rainwater runoff directly into local waterways. Chip often receives calls about storm drains and ditches, which are part of the stormwater system—not the sanitary sewer.

As for how customers can help? Chip is clear: "There's no such thing as a flushable wipe." Wipes cause most sewer clogs, so please stick to the 4 Ps of Flushing: Pee, Poo, Paper, and Puke.
