

## Mitchell Bridge Road and Athens West Parkway Intersection Improvement

**Purpose:**

The Mitchell Bridge Road widening and Athens West Parkway intersection at Mitchell Bridge Road project addressed the future increased traffic demands along the Atlanta Highway corridor and intersecting roads, per the Atlanta Highway Master Plan. The first approved element to improve this area was a left turn lane onto Athens West Parkway.

**Project Details:**

The project consists of widening on the western side of Mitchell Bridge Road for approximately 2,500 ft. The widening will create a dedicated left-turn lane for Athens West Parkway and for The Preserve Drive.

Notes: *\* The original concept presented to Mayor & Commission in March 2009, included a realignment of Athens West Parkway, and the Preserve Drive at Mitchell Bridge Road to create a four-legged signalized intersection. Instead, M&C requested a more thorough design, including sidewalks and bike paths. An initial improvement was suggested, to add only a left turn lane at the intersection of Mitchell Bridge Road to Athens West Parkway as a temporary fix. The revised concept was approved in August 2009.*
