


Clean Water Homes

Rain Barrels

What are rain barrels?

Rain barrels catch rainwater from roofs that would otherwise become runoff and store it for later use.



Why install a rain barrel?

- Low cost, big impact.
- Lower water bills.
- Reduces water pollution.
- Reduces flooding.
- Conserves water.



Keep in mind:

- Get a free rain barrel at one of our rain barrel workshops.
- Captured water can contain chemicals from the roof or barrel. Do not consume.
- If you have a large property, consider expanding to multiple barrels or a cistern.

Rain Gardens

What are rain gardens?

Rain gardens are shallow basins with water-loving plants that catch rainwater and allow it to filter.



Why install a rain garden?

- Beautifies the home.
- Creates habitat for wildlife.
- Reduces water pollution.
- Reduces flooding.
- Can increase home value.



Keep in mind:

- Rain gardens must be appropriately placed and composed of the correct soils to be effective. Contact a professional if you have questions.
- Rain gardens require some maintenance. Just weed, water, and apply mulch as necessary.
