What's the problem with pet waste?



Lucy is one of the many dogs that live in Athens-Clarke County. She likes to go on walks, visit local dog parks, and demand attention.

While Lucy's waste is not enough to hurt our health or our waterways, the waste from many dogs is. Urban areas, such as Athens, need to address pet waste because they have more waste than natural areas.

The combined impact from all of these dogs can harm our health and our water.



When it rains, stormwater runoff travels along sidewalks and roads, picking up pollutants, such as pet waste, on its way to the storm drains. From there, it flows directly into our waterways.

Pet waste can:



kill aquatic life and disrupt stream habitats as it decays by using up oxygen necessary for plants and animals to survive.



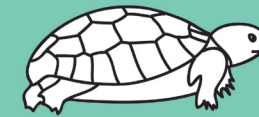
contain bacteria and parasites, such as *E. coli* and roundworm, which can make people sick.



contain nutrients plants use, leading to large algae growth. The algae uses up oxygen necessary for animals and more beneficial plants to survive.

When our waters are polluted by pet waste:

we can no longer use our waters for swimming or fishing.



plants and animals struggle to survive.

drinking water treatment is more costly and difficult.
