### GENERAL INFO

- Trails are for designated use only.
- No bicycles are allowed on any trails.
- Horses are only allowed on Buckeye Horse Trail.
- Stay on official marked trails.
- Upon entering the park, individuals with horses must produce proof of Negative Coggins Report at the gatehouse.

#### Trail Rules

- No plant removal
- Do not feed wildlife
- Swimming is only allowed in designated areas
- Fishing is only allowed in designated areas
- No amplified sound, except by permit
- Motor vehicles must remain on paved roads and must park only in designated parking spaces
- Bikes must remain on paved roads

#### PARK RULES

##### Boating Rules

- Gasoline powered motors are prohibited at all times.
- All Georgia Boating and Fishing Regulations must be observed on the lake.
- All boats, including rafts, canoes, and kayaks must have one U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device per person on board.

##### General Rules

The Park gates are locked at posted closing times. Persons remaining in the park after hours may be ticketed and towed according to ACC Ordinances.

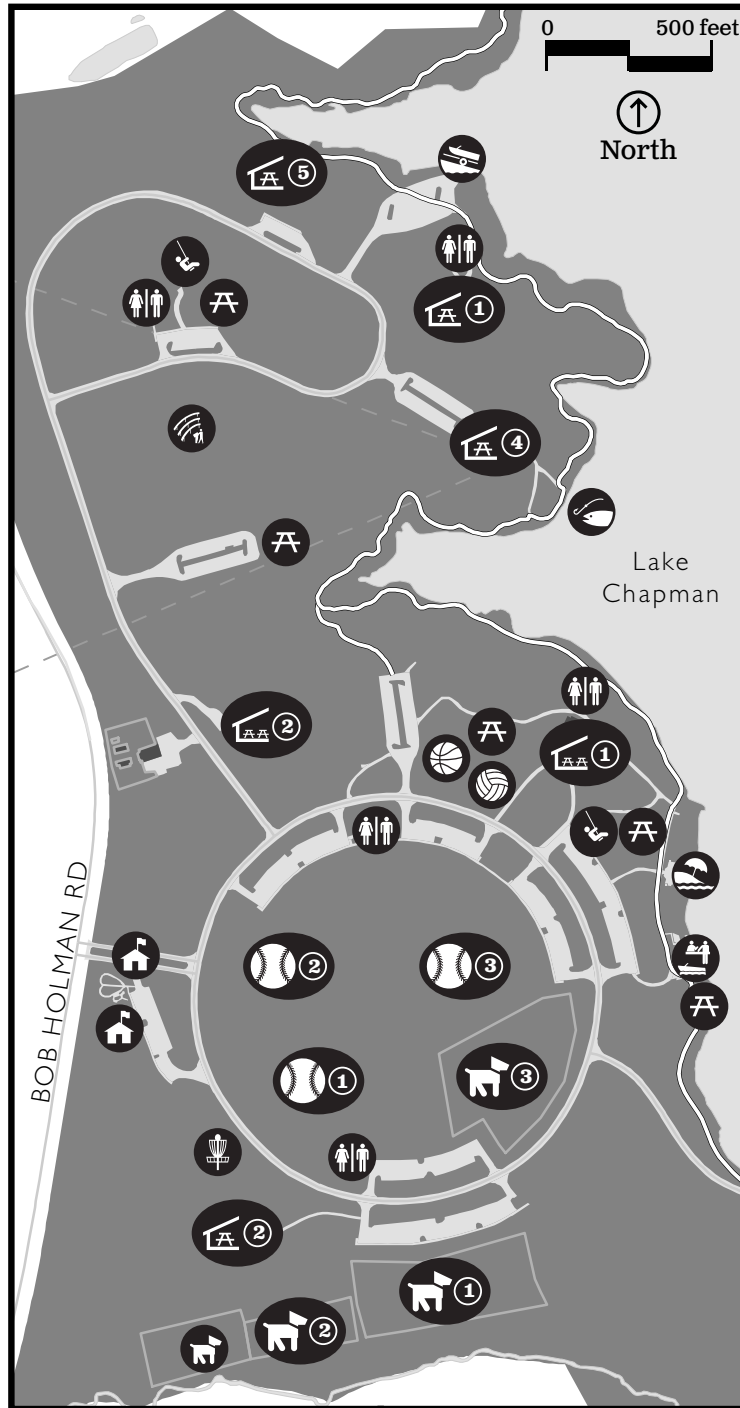
