# 2018 - 2019 ACC GREEN SCHOOL PROGRAM & ACTIVITY GUIDE

The Athens-Clarke County (ACC) Green School Program is designed to assist schools and teachers with environmental education and improvement efforts. The activities and lessons included in the program focus on conservation, preservation, and beautification of our environment. The joint effort between multiple ACC organizations supports schools with expanded educational opportunities and community engagement.

## ACC Green School Program Guidelines

- Each school has a Green School Coordinator who submits the Green School registration form and any schoolwide activities.
- To participate in the program, each school must complete the online registration form by September 30.
- Schools must earn at least 25 points by completing approved Green School activities to earn Green School status. Eligible activities are worth 1 or 2 points each.
- Teachers will submit their Green School activities via an online submission form. These points will go toward the school's total and each teacher is also eligible to become a Green Teacher after earning 5 individual points.
- Green School activities and lessons listed in this guide come from different Activity Sources, which is how they are classified and recorded in the online submission form. Sources include the ACC Recycling Division, Keep Athens-Clarke County Beautiful, the UGA-ACC Extension Office, ACC Stormwater, the ACC Water Conservation Office, and other organizations.
- Green School Teachers can submit activities/curriculums that are NOT included in this guide for consideration for credit (there are also additional activities listed on the online Activity Submission Form).
- All activities must be submitted to the program to receive Green School points by April 30 of each year.
