## Project Background

- ACC Animal Shelter is located at 125 Buddy Christian Way
- Built 30 years ago with 30 dog runs
- Expanded in 2016 by SPLOST 2011 to add cat shelter, 6 new dog runs, dog quarantine area, and outdoor interaction pens
- Shelter is licensed to operate by the Georgia Department of Agriculture which performs periodic inspections
- In summer 2018, GaDA inspector identified deficiencies in original dog runs caused by the age of the facility

## Project Background

- The 30 original dog runs are 30 years old
- Constructed of concrete block and chain link fencing with an indoor and an outdoor section in each run
- Cleaning chemicals corrode fencing
- Concrete blocks have become cracked with pieces missing
- Cleaning protocols expose dogs to chemicals due to lack of indoor drains

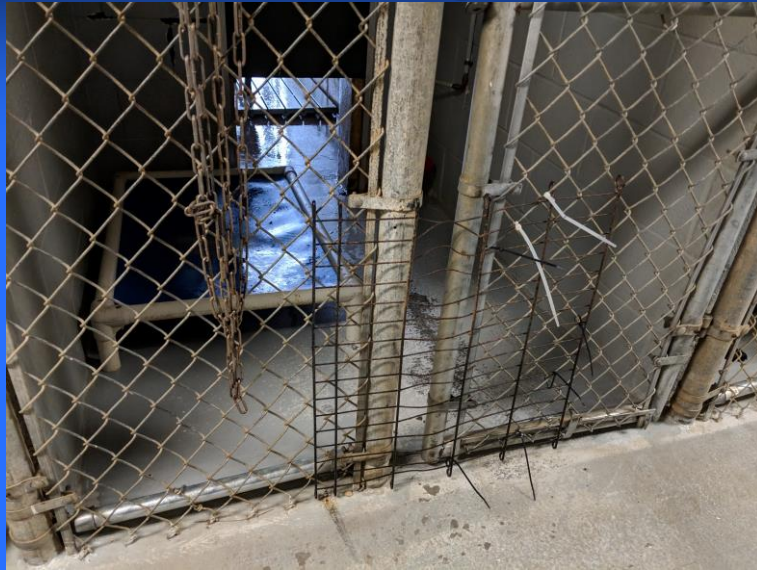

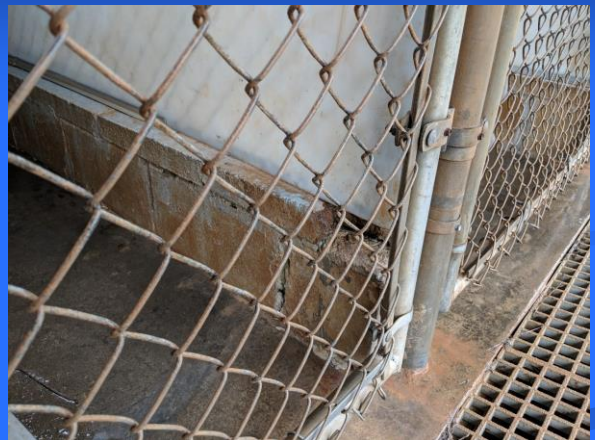

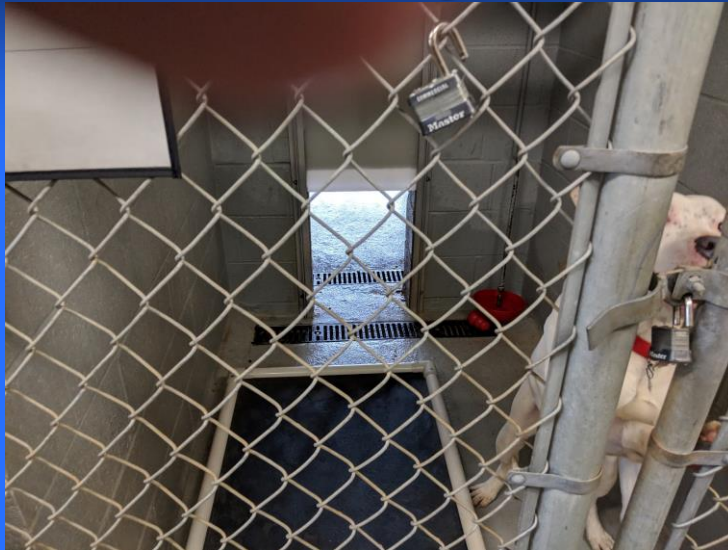

## Project Elements & Goals

- Renovate or reconstruct the 30 original dog kennel runs with improved materials to improve the ability to maintain safe and sanitary conditions required to maintain compliance with Georgia Department of Agriculture laws and regulations.
- The project may also provide functional and cosmetic improvements to the front office and public spaces in and around the shelter that were not improved in SPLOST 2011 project.

## Proposed Budget

### ■ Animal Shelter Renovations
