Did you know that our education program encompasses K-12, business, and public education and outreach? In 2019 alone, the Stormwater Education Specialist conducted 38 K-12/youth activities, participated in 6 business outreach events, attended 8 public events, and hosted 21 workshops or presentations for community groups. We consider education and public awareness a critical piece of stormwater management and will continue to strive for excellence in our programming.
