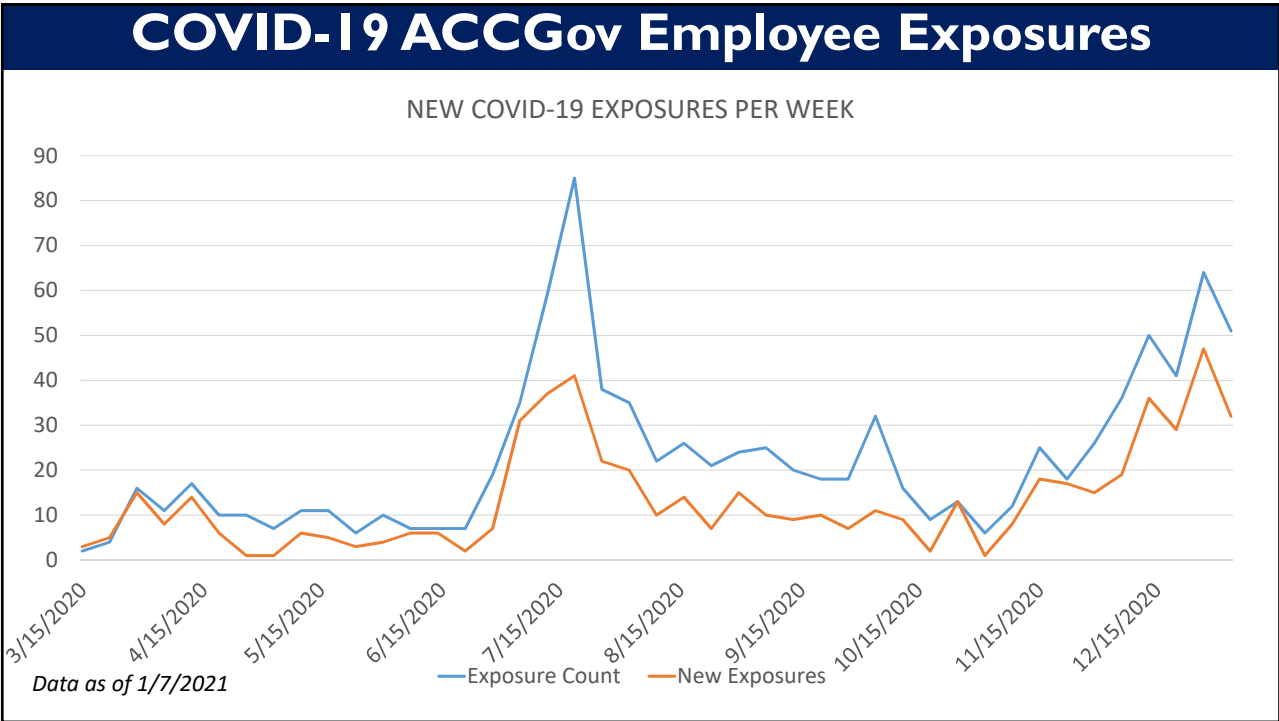

Enforcement Update: Bar Occupancy Checks

- Between December 3 and December 19, officers conducted an additional 101 bar occupancy checks. Two non-compliant bars received a verbal warning, and three were cited.

December 11- December 12	48	5
December 19	9	0

- The additional bar occupancy checks brings the total number of checks to 1,201.

Enforcement Update: Facemask Enforcement

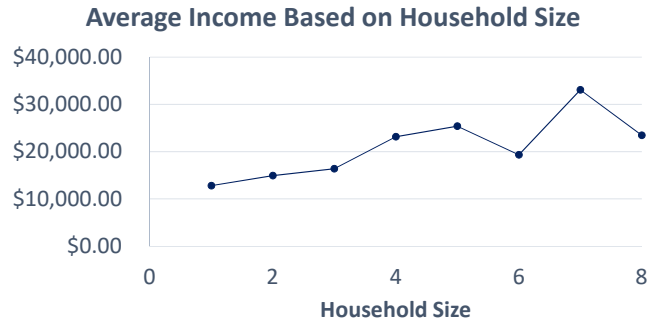
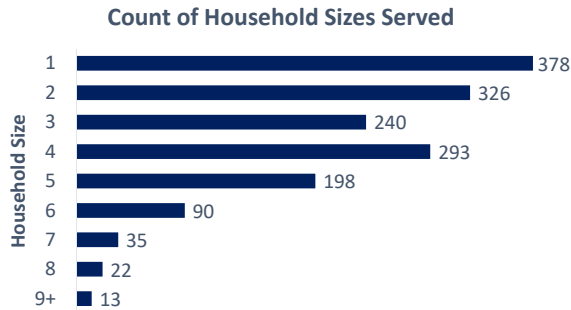
Between December 4 and December 12, officers distributed a total of **551 facemasks** and issued **312 warnings** for non-compliance. No citations were issued for failing to wear a mask after being warned.

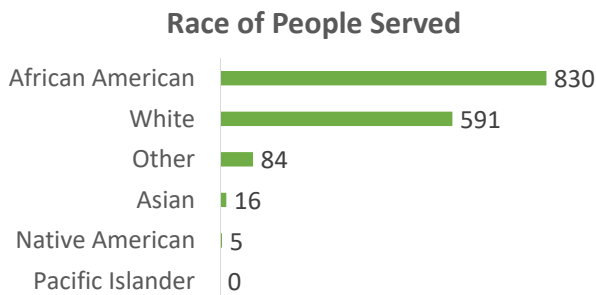
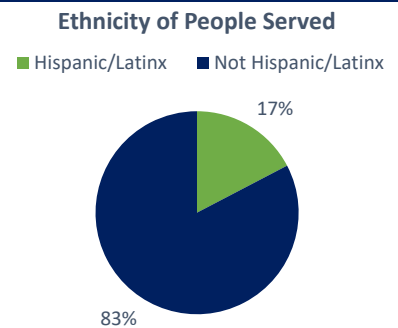
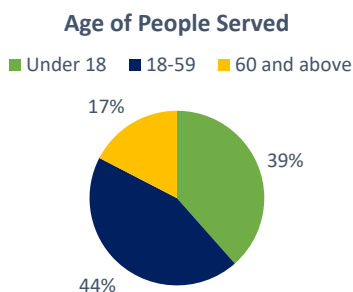
