I live in mountainous areas, forests, and occasionally swamps. I'm a forager who feeds mostly on grasses, roots, berries, insects, and sometimes human-generated trash if I'm misbehaving! I can grow to be over 500 pounds.

You can find me in freshwater habitats such as swamps, rivers, streams, and lakes. I have 75 to 85 teeth at a time, but I grow up to 1,000 teeth in a lifetime. I'm hungry for fish and small mammals...and ice cream sandwiches!

I am a marsupial, which means I carry my young in a pouch. If I come in contact with a predator, I get very stressed and will "play" dead until they go away. I'm new here at the zoo! You might not see me on your scavenger hunt at the zoo because my house is still being built. Can you help me find it?

Psssssst! Down here! I'm found in South and Southeast Asia. If I come in contact with a predator I will expand my ribs and muscles on both sides of my neck to create what's called a "hood." The hood makes me appear extra-big.
