

**MEMO OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING
SHARED USE OF RECREATIONAL FACILITIES BETWEEN ATHENS-CLARKE
COUNTY UNIFIED GOVERNMENT AND CLARKE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

PURPOSE

Clarke County School District (CCSD) and Unified Government of Athens-Clarke County (ACC) recognize the financial and social benefits to the community entering into a partnership for the joint use of CCSD and ACC recreation property and facilities. The purpose of this Agreement is to maximize the educational and recreational facilities and opportunities for the residents of Athens-Clarke County in the most cost effective manner.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

Single Point of Contact – Each party shall appoint a single point of contact who shall be responsible for coordinating with the other to ensure that the various provisions of this Agreement are fulfilled.

Facilities Covered – CCSD and ACC agree to share the use of all recreational facilities (indoor/outdoor) and equipment when possible at those sites set forth in Exhibit A. Both parties agree to make all facilities available if the use does not interfere with the normal operational use of facilities for school / public purposes. Equipment may be used upon agreement of both parties and only after designated staff have been trained and authorized for use. Special considerations may be given to certain educational / recreational programs and uses.

FACILITY MAINTENANCE

Repair and Maintenance Responsibilities – Each party shall be responsible for maintaining their respective property in a state of good repair, providing day-to-day maintenance, janitorial services, and structural repair, and replacing or repairing any major equipment. Damage due to improper use by the other party may result in reimbursement of costs to repair.

OPERATION

Contact - A single point of contact shall be delegated for both ACC and CCSD. It is the intention of the parties to maximize the facility usage opportunities without conflict with school business or leisure operations. The single point of contact shall be responsible for ensuring that a written response to the request is provided. In the event a request is denied, the reason for denial shall be stated in the written response.

Priority Use and Scheduling of Recreational Facilities – When CCSD facilities are not being used by CCSD for its own purposes or other contractual obligations, ACC shall have first priority for their use and shall request such use through the CCSD's single point of contact.

When ACC facilities are not being used by ACC for its own purposes to include contractual obligations from outside agencies, CCSD shall have first priority for their use and shall request such use through the ACC's single point of contact

Supervision of Activities and Regulation of Use –CCSD and ACC shall be responsible for supervising their own scheduled activities at the other party's facilities. Use of CCSD and ACC facilities at all times shall comply with the applicable federal, state, or local law or the policies of either CCSD or ACC.

CCSD or ACC shall have the authority to deny use to or remove any individuals or groups whose activities are deemed to be unduly harmful to the park facility, school grounds, or facilities, or whose activities are in violation of federal, state, or local law or the policies or procedures of either CCSD or ACC.

ACC requires the following adult: student ratio for all CCSD usage of its facilities:
Preschool or Elementary School- 1 adult: 10 students
Middle or High School- 1 adult: 15 students

Grievances- If CCSD or ACC encounters significant concerns upon use of the other party's facilities, or experiences significant concerns because of the other party's usage of their facilities, those concerns should be relayed through the organizations recognized single point of contact who will notify pertinent staff and management to reach a mutually agreeable resolution.

COMPENSATION

No fees shall be charged to CCSD or ACC for the use of the subject facilities as described hereon unless use of the facilities requires staffing beyond normal duty hours, in which case an appropriate fee shall be assessed that is agreed upon by both parties. ACC reserves the right to charge for admission/entrance fees to performances or other programs.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

Liability of the parties to each other and to third parties shall be determined according to Georgia law.

Conditions of Use

By signing below, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- All stated rules of the host agency and the host facility must be followed. Any special instructions provided by site staff are to be followed.
- Sites should be treated with respect and left in the state in which they were found. Users are responsible for putting any trash into appropriate containers, cleaning up any litter they produce, placing tables and chairs in original positions, etc.
- Water balloons, water guns and any other water play toys are prohibited at all Leisure Services facilities unless specific permission is granted. Any activities that will likely create a good bit of debris or mess must be pre-approved.
- ACC requires the following supervision ratio for school groups visiting our parks:

Preschool or Elementary School: 1 adult/10 students

Middle or High School: 1 adult/15 students

- Any violation of the conditions of use may result in immediate termination of the event and/or charges for damaged property and/or the suspension of future activities by the school/group at the host site.
