


East Athens Neighborhood Pavement Management

- Milling and resurfacing on Fairview Drive, entire length of approximately 3,200 lane miles.
- Resurfacing of other streets within the East Athens Neighborhood as required.

In what specific ways will this project “Close the Equity Gap” in Athens-Clarke County, by improving the Equitability of Capital Improvements throughout the entire community?


The project provides capital improvements to the East Athens Neighborhood, a traditionally underserved area of our community.


How will this project address one or more of the Mayor and Commission approved Strategic Commitments and Project Selection Criteria?
