

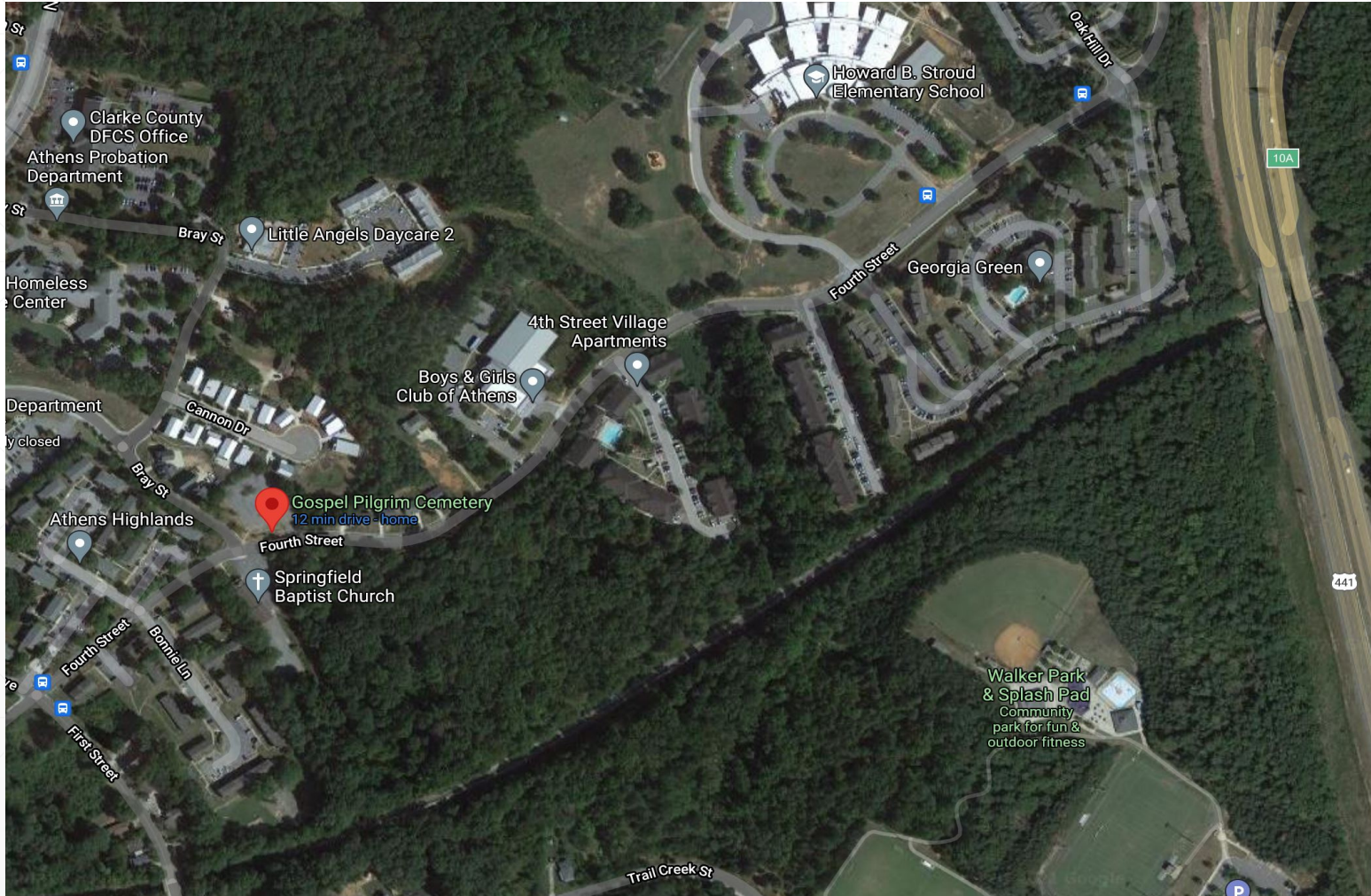

 - The project invests in infrastructure that addresses health and safety by providing greater access to recreational facilities.
 - The project highlights Gospel Pilgrim Cemetery, a significant cultural resource in the community.

How will this project address one or more of the Mayor and Commission approved Strategic Commitments and Project Selection Criteria?

- **Promotes increased access to existing public facilities** by promoting bike and pedestrian connectivity.
 - **Promotes Health and Safety** by providing opportunities for active mobility through bike and pedestrian activities and improved access to a significant neighborhood recreational facility, Virginia Callaway-Cofer Walker Park.
 - **Continues Sidewalk & Multi-Use Trail construction** by promoting bike and pedestrian connectivity between Virginia Callaway-Cofer Walker Park, Gospel Pilgrim Cemetery, the Boys and Girls Club, and Howard B. Stroud Elementary School. The project is an extension of the Vine St-Trail Creek Greenway Trail.
 - **Implements components of an updated Greenway Network Plan** as it is an extension of the Vine St-Trail Creek Greenway Trail as shown on the 2020 Greenway Masterplan, Northeast Quadrant Map.

- This project positively impacts **Economic Prosperity** and **Social Well-being** by promoting bike and pedestrian connectivity between Virginia Callaway-Cofer Walker Park, Gospel Pilgrim Cemetery, the Boys and Girls Club, and Howard B.
