Expanding Access to Sandy Creek Park

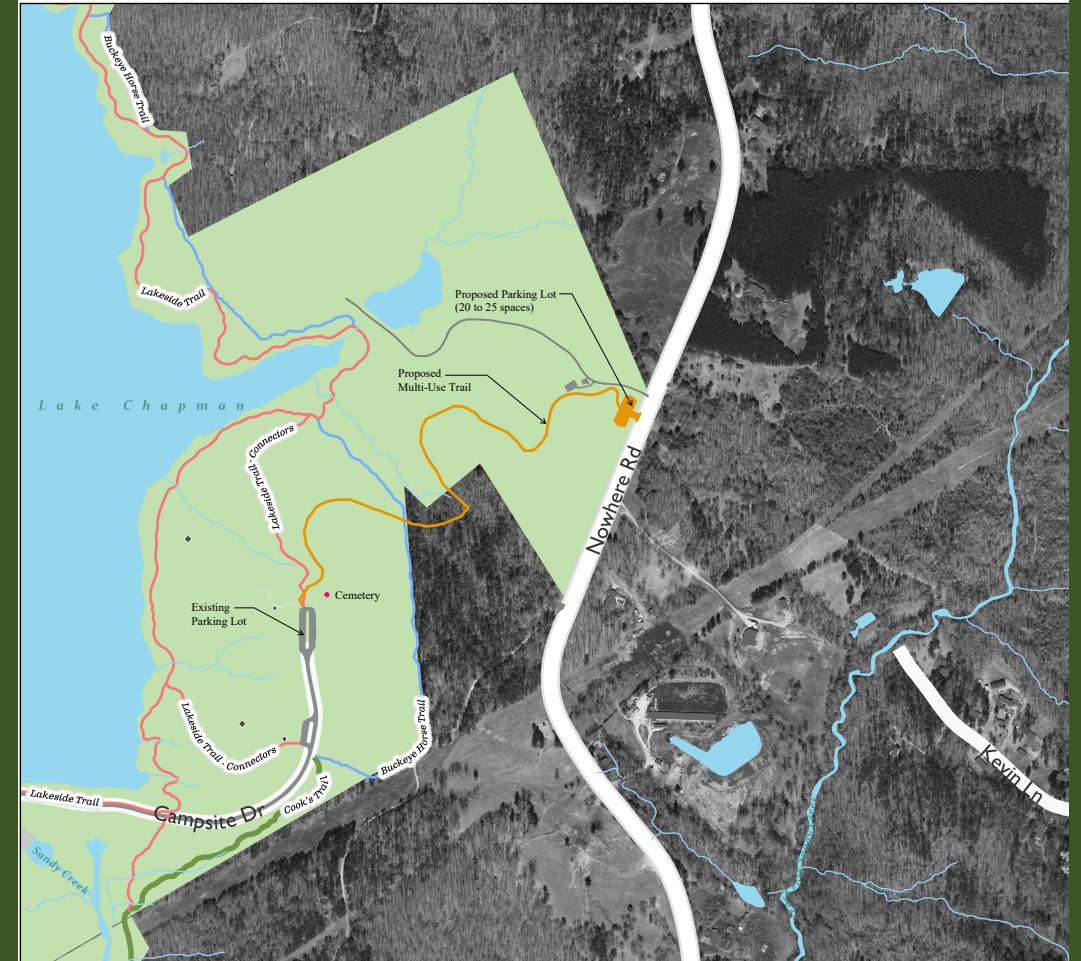
- Expand Access to Sandy Creek Park

- Access to 16 miles of Walking Trails
- Sports fields



Solution

Expanding Access to Sandy Creek Park

- Paved parking lot 20-25 Cars
- Approximately ½ mile Paved Multi-Use Trail
- Provides Walking and Bicycle Access
- Pay to Park Via ACC Mobile APP

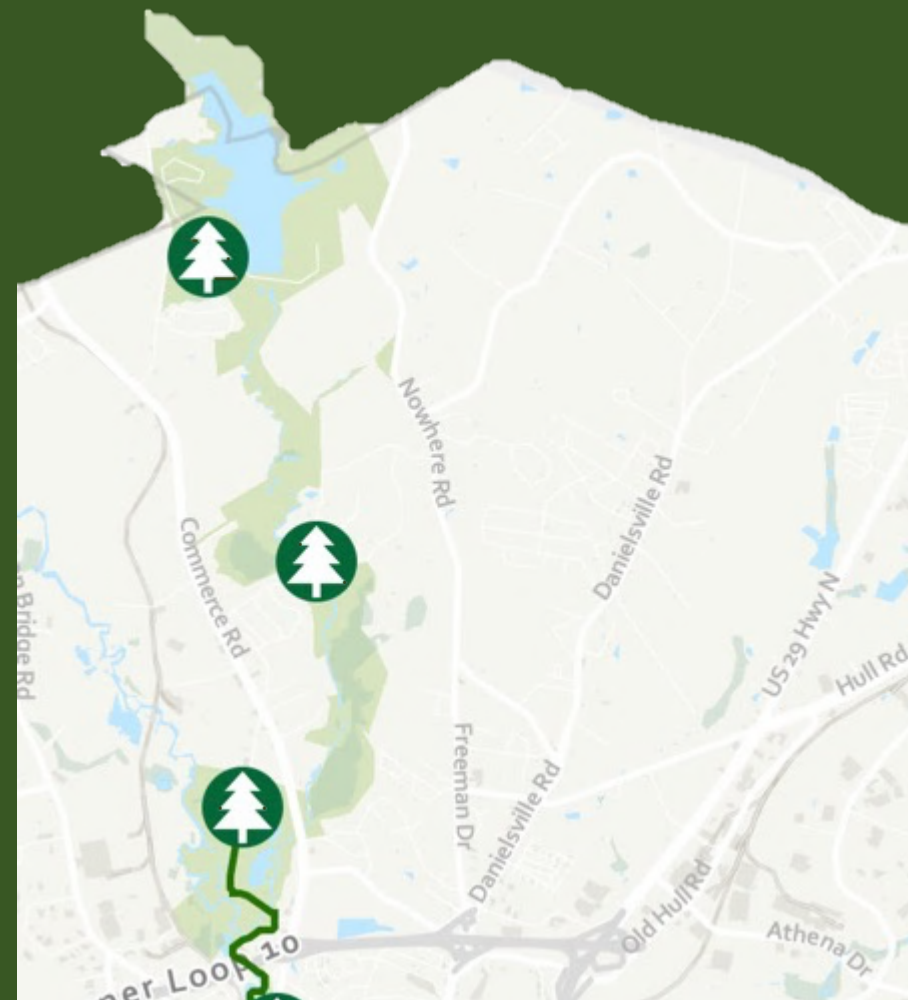

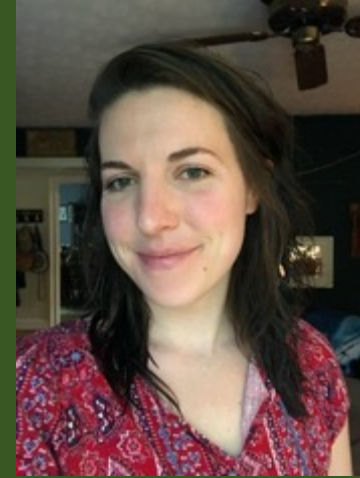
