Help Protect Athens Water Resources - Volunteer for Rivers Alive



Site sign-ups are underway for the 2021 Athens Rivers Alive event on Saturday, October 23. [Online registration](#) will close on Monday, October 18, so go ahead and reserve your spot today! Registration is required to participate.

Rivers Alive is Georgia's annual volunteer river clean-up event that encourages civic involvement in the preservation of Georgia's precious water resources. Our waterways provide us with fresh drinking water, important wildlife habitat, and recreational opportunities that serve as a respite from our day-to-day lives - now more than ever!

This year's event will look slightly different due to COVID-19. We will not be hosting a kick-off event, and we will not accommodate any walk-up/day-of volunteer registration. All volunteers must pre-register on our GivePulse page, which requires reading and signing-off on the Rivers Alive COVID-19 Agreement. We are also offering an [independent clean-up opportunity](#) for those who are not comfortable participating in larger group sites.

On the morning of the event, volunteers will meet directly at their chosen sites and should bring a reusable water bottle, bug spray, wear long pants and close-toed shoes, and come prepared to get wet and dirty.
