## CHARACTER LIST

**Winnie Foster** An 11 year old girl who has lost her father. She is too skeptical for her age, but with an unknown longing for romance and adventure.

**Mother** Winnie's mother. She is a gentle woman almost broken by grief. Adversity finds her brave and unbending.

Gender: Female

**Nana** Winnie's grandmother. A loopy old woman but a loving grandmother and mother.

**Jesse Tuck** The youngest of the Tuck family. He is lighthearted and humorous but with a shadow of loneliness that he has.

**Miles Tuck** Jesse's older brother. Miles is a burned and bitter man. His natural sweetness is shut away. He lost his wife and child and is now doomed to live with regret.

**Mae Tuck** Jesse's mother. She is still beautiful after all of these years, a matriarch, a mother, a wife. Her homespun wisdom is leavened by her humor and still girlish delight.

**Angus Tuck** Jesse's Father. Once awakened he is a vibrant man. He is an indulgent father, a fond husband. A true soul with a deep well of love and profound understanding of the life around him.

**Man in the Yellow Suit** A nefarious leader of a travelling carnival, in search of the fountain of youth. He is a creepy and persuasive man with an obsession and a secret.
