**CDBG-CV Funding Recommendations**  
 (Listed in Order of Proposal Score)

1. Project Safe .....\$ 92,076  
*To provide financial assistance for short-term housing costs and childcare for income qualified individuals/households experiencing domestic violence. The project targets serving 25 households.*
  
2. Acceptance Recovery Center.....\$100,005  
*To pay the admission fees, program fees, housing costs, and childcare supplements for income qualified individuals who participate in a residential addiction recovery program. The project targets new admission for 57 individuals, with general financial support for 127 (new and existing) program participants.*
  
3. The Ark UMOC.....\$100,000  
*To provide financial assistance for rent and utility costs for income qualified individuals/households. The project targets serving 100 households.*
  
4. Advantage Behavioral Health Systems.....\$291,856  
*To continue a program that provides short-term emergency shelter through hotel/motel vouchers and client case management to individuals/households experiencing homelessness. The project targets serving 30 households using 14 hotel units, though it may need to be reduced to reflect partial funding.*
  
5. Advantage Behavioral Health Systems.....\$100,000  
*To provide rehousing assistance to enable individuals/households participating in the hotel/motel voucher program to transition to stable, independent living. The project targets serving 12 households, though it may need to be reduced to reflect partial funding.*
  
6. Family Promise of Athens..... \$120,000  
*To fund security deposits, rent, and/or utility assistance to income qualified families (minimum of 1 adult and 1 child). The project targets serving 80 families.*
  
7. Action, Inc.....\$ 0  
*To provide financial assistance for short-term housing costs and/or hotel vouchers for income qualified households. The project targets serving 30 households.*
